Hope you have a Happy 4th of July and that we see you at the library soon!!



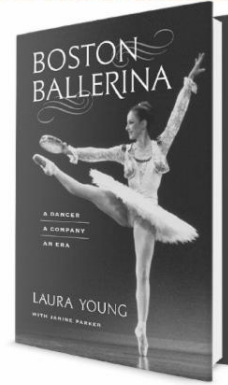
Marstons Mills Public Library welcomes...


